Who We Are

Anniston Army Depot (ANAD) is the combat vehicle depot for repair, modification, upgrade and conversion of all heavy and light tracked vehicles (except the Bradley), assault bridging, towed and self-propelled artillery as well as small arms for America's defense forces and allies. ANAD is also the repair depot for locomotives, rail equipment and non-tactical generators.

- **Small Arms:**
Overhauled/Repaired: M1 series rifle, M2 series machine gun, MK19 40mm machine gun, M9 pistol, M16 series rifle, M60 series machine gun, M134 mini gun, M240 series machine gun, M249 squad automatic weapon, M1911 pistol, M230 chain gun, M14 enhanced battle rifle, grenade launchers, mortars, gun mounts and shotguns.

What We Do

- **Combat vehicles:**
Overhauled/Repaired: M1 Abrams family of vehicles, M113 family of vehicles, M88 family of vehicles, M9 Armored Combat Engineering, M60 Armored Vehicle Launched Bridge, Wolverine bridge system and the Stryker family of vehicles.
- **Combat vehicles:**
Built new: Joint Assault Bridge (JAB), Assault Breacher Vehicle (ABV) and Stryker (in partnership with General Dynamics Land Systems).
- **Artillery:**
Overhauled/Repaired: M198, M119 and M102 towed Howitzers, M777A2 lightweight Howitzer, and M109 Paladin self-propelled Howitzer as well as the Field Artillery Ammunition Supply Vehicle (FAASV).
