They serve as our Strategic Power Projection Platform providing logistics support for asset receipt, classification, management, storage, distribution, maintenance, assembly & containerization, and the rapid worldwide shipment of material in support of the war fighter.

What We Do

- Maintenance & Reset
 - The Secretary of the Army designated Sierra Army Depot as the Center for Industrial Technical Excellence (CITE) for all Petroleum and Water Systems (PAWS):
 - An extensive maintenance capability that includes; Fabrication, Reset, rebuild, machining, corrosion control, multi-media blasting, painting, and extensive welding (MIG, TIG, ARC)
- Equipment Long Term Storage
 - Serve as the Army's End of First Life Center for Ground Combat and Combat Support Vehicles
 - Inventory Management
- Asset Reclamation & Redistribution
 - The Army's largest Class IX retrograde Supply Support Activity
 - The Army's only Non Standard Equipment Redistribution Center
- Clothing Management
 - Storing \$1B in clothing inventory issuing to all Army Reserve Forces, world wide
 - Inspect, repair and return ballistic / ceramic plates to the Army; identify plates to be used for Training Purposes Only
